UAL MFA Year 1 Canary Wharf Residency – Summer 2016

Outline

There is an opportunity to work on the Canary Wharf Estate on the Isle of Dogs, E14 5AB for a summer residency.

Canary Wharf is a 97-acre office and retail space created from disused Docklands (http://group.canarywharf.com/)

The space is two attached offices within the site accommodation complex for a new multi-storey tower.

The space is available from 4 July to 30 September and it may be possible to split this period into weekly blocks. The space is available from Monday to Friday and possible Saturday mornings.

The space provides a "studio" (7.00m x 4.60m) comfortably for four artists and a "clean" or "quiet room" (6.00m x 4.00m) for two further artists and meeting/discussion space.

Electricity is available and it is understood that wifi will also available. There is no running water or sink facilities available in the space although toilet and welfare facilities are provided in separate areas.

It is intended to involve the Arts and Event team of Canary Wharf to see if the work can be opened up to a wider audience.

Artists will be required to:

- Sign an Agreement between the organiser and themselves
- Abide by the Residency Agreement
- Attend timetabled crits (at mutually agreed times)
- Create a body of work to show at a later date
- Provide Public Liability Insurance (available through an a-n magazine Subscription https://www.a-n.co.uk/about/insurance or Sharrocks enquiries@sharrock-insurance.com

Photography, video and any other work outside of the space and on the Canary Wharf estate is possible but a separate permit is required from the Press and Publicity Department, any requirement should be clearly stated in the proposal.

If you are interested please complete the attached Proposal Form identifying:

- Outline proposal of the work, which must reflect Canary Wharf
- Length of residency required and number of days you would wish to be present
- Any requirement for photography/video etc. permit (will need a separate Canary Wharf Form and takes a few days to provide)
